
INTERNAL GROWTH

BY 2027

we aim to engage at least **50** young individuals—particularly from underserved communities—into volunteer opportunities with USYF.



OVER THE NEXT TWO YEARS

Over the next two years, we will empower our youth volunteers to collaborate, plan, and execute a minimum of **10** youth-centered civic engagement campaigns that inspire change and action within their communities.

By focusing on internal growth, we hope to create a community of youth who are equipped to lead, inspire, and make lasting contributions to the world around them.




EXTERNAL GROWTH AND IMPACT
